The Maylands Peninsula Primary School P&C invite




you to come along to a special family fun night at Scitech. The event coincides

Connect through Sport Xceler8 is a free monthly sports program for children aged 9-12 years held at The



RISE in Maylands. The idea behind the program is to 'connect through sport', to use sport to create an environment where children feel encouraged, loved, connected and hopefully make some friends on the day! We are running the

program for children who may not have the opportunity to participate in a regular social sport (due to difficult family circumstance or financial/social disadvantage) or who would benefit from the fun, fitness and being a valued team member. Each afternoon runs for 2 hours and starts with learning the skills for the sport of the month, followed by a game with afternoon tea provided. We encourage parents to stay and cheer on their children and enjoy the afternoon tea. The first event kicked off in May with basketball being the sport of choice for May, June and the next event coming up on 26th July.
